

Context7 Addendum — Upstash Terms of Service & Privacy Policy

Effective Date: August 2025

This Context7 Addendum ("Addendum") supplements and amends the Upstash Terms of Service (available at <https://upstash.com/trust/terms.pdf>) and Privacy Policy (available at <https://upstash.com/trust/privacy.pdf>) for all uses of the Context7 service ("Context7 Addendum"). Use of Context7 constitutes acceptance of this Addendum. In case of conflict between this Addendum and the main Terms of Service or Privacy Policy, this Addendum controls with respect to Context7.

1. Definitions

- **"Context7"**: The Upstash documentation service that provides up-to-date, version-specific library and framework documentation through MCP (Model Context Protocol) servers, web interfaces, and APIs.
- **"Authorized User"**: Individuals or agents permitted by Customer to use Context7, including developers, team members, or AI assistants acting on Customer's behalf.
- **"Input"**: Prompts, queries, library names, version specifications, topics, or other information submitted by Customer or Authorized Users to Context7.
- **"Output"**: Documentation content, code snippets, API references, or other information provided by Context7 in response to Input.
- **"Documentation Data"**: Processed and indexed documentation from open-source libraries, frameworks, and other software projects made available through Context7.
- **"MCP Integration"**: Model Context Protocol server connections that enable AI coding assistants to automatically fetch Context7 content.

2. Service Description and License Grant

Upstash grants Customer and Authorized Users a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to access and use Context7 for internal development, educational, and evaluation purposes during the Term. Context7 provides:

- Real-time access to up-to-date documentation for software libraries and frameworks
- Version-specific code examples and API references
- Semantic search and content filtering capabilities
- Integration with AI coding assistants via MCP
- Manual web-based documentation retrieval

3. Customer Responsibilities

Customer shall:

- Ensure Inputs comply with applicable laws and do not contain malware or infringe third-party rights
- Review and verify all Outputs before utilizing them in production environments
- Maintain security of account credentials and API keys, and promptly report any suspected breaches
- Ensure Authorized Users comply with this Addendum and the main Terms of Service
- Use Context7 only for legitimate software development and educational purposes

4. Usage Restrictions

Customer shall not:

- Reverse engineer, reproduce, or attempt to replicate Context7's infrastructure or indexing systems
- Use Outputs to build competing documentation services or train competing AI models
- Distribute, sublicense, or transfer MCP server configurations or API keys to unauthorized parties
- Extract documentation content in bulk for unauthorized redistribution or commercial use
- Circumvent rate limits, access controls, or other protective measures within Context7
- Use Context7 to process sensitive personal information, health data, or other regulated content
- Access Context7 through automated methods beyond the intended MCP and API interfaces

5. Data Handling and Privacy

5.1 Documentation Data

- Context7 aggregates publicly available documentation from open-source projects and official library sources
- Documentation Data is processed, indexed, and served according to Upstash's standard data handling practices
- Customer acknowledges that Documentation Data originates from third-party sources and may be subject to those sources' licenses and terms

5.2 Customer Data

- Customer Inputs and usage patterns are treated as "Customer Data" under Upstash's Privacy Policy

- Upstash will not use Customer Inputs for marketing, model training, or resale without explicit consent
- Processing of Customer data is strictly limited to providing Context7 services and maintaining system security

5.3 Community Contributions

- Context7 may incorporate community-sourced project additions and documentation updates
- Customer should promptly report any inaccurate, outdated, or problematic documentation content
- Upstash is not responsible for the accuracy or security of community-contributed content

6. Intellectual Property and Content Rights

6.1 Documentation Content

- Documentation Data remains subject to the original licenses and intellectual property rights of the respective software projects
- Customer is responsible for ensuring compliance with any applicable open-source licenses or terms of use
- Context7 does not grant additional rights beyond those already available in the original documentation sources

6.2 Customer Content

- Customer retains ownership of Inputs provided to Context7
- Upstash may use Customer Inputs solely to provide Context7 services, improve service quality, and ensure security
- Customer grants Upstash the necessary rights to process Inputs for service delivery

6.3 Service Rights

- Upstash retains all rights to Context7's infrastructure, algorithms, and service delivery mechanisms
- The Context7 brand, interface, and API designs remain Upstash's intellectual property

7. Service Availability and Disclaimers

7.1 Service Availability

- Context7 is provided on a best-effort basis as part of Upstash's service ecosystem

- Upstash may update, modify, or temporarily suspend Context7 for maintenance or security purposes
- Upstash will provide reasonable notice of planned service disruptions when possible

7.2 Content Disclaimers

- Context7 is provided "as is" without warranties of completeness, accuracy, or fitness for specific purposes
- Documentation Outputs may be incomplete, outdated, or inaccurate due to the rapidly changing nature of software libraries
- Customer must validate all Outputs before use in production environments
- Upstash disclaims liability for damages arising from reliance on Context7 content or service interruptions

8. Security and Compliance

8.1 Security Framework

- Customer data transmission is encrypted and processed according to industry standards
- Upstash maintains appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect Customer data

8.2 Regulatory Compliance

- Customer must ensure Context7 usage complies with applicable laws including GDPR, CCPA, and other data protection regulations
- Context7 offers no additional compliance guarantees beyond those provided in Upstash's main Terms of Service
- Customer is responsible for conducting appropriate due diligence for regulated environments

9. Updates and Modifications

9.1 Addendum Changes

- Upstash reserves the right to modify, update, or amend this Addendum at any time at its sole discretion
- Upstash will provide notice of material changes by posting the updated Addendum on the website or through other reasonable means
- Continued use of Context7 after any changes become effective constitutes Customer's acceptance of the modified Addendum
- If Customer does not agree to any changes, Customer's sole remedy is to discontinue use of Context7

9.2 Service Updates

- Upstash may update Context7 features, documentation sources, and indexing algorithms to improve service quality
- Service modifications may be implemented without prior notice when necessary for security, performance, or operational reasons
- Material changes to Context7 functionality will be communicated with reasonable advance notice when feasible

9.3 Documentation Updates

- Context7 documentation indices are updated regularly based on availability and priority
- Upstash does not guarantee specific update frequencies for particular libraries or frameworks
- Users may request priority updates for specific documentation sources through designated channels

10. Termination and Effect

10.1 Termination Rights

- Either party may discontinue use of Context7 with reasonable notice
- Upstash may suspend or terminate Context7 access for violations of this Addendum or the main Terms of Service
- Customer must cease use of Context7 upon termination and may be required to delete cached Outputs if requested

10.2 Survival

- Sections related to intellectual property, disclaimers, and limitation of liability survive termination
- Customer's rights to use previously obtained Outputs continue subject to applicable license terms

11. Support and Maintenance

- Context7 support is provided through Upstash's standard support channels
- Support covers service availability, API functionality, and general usage questions
- Documentation accuracy issues should be reported for review and potential correction
- No dedicated professional services are provided specifically for Context7

12. Limitation of Liability

The limitation of liability provisions in the main Upstash Terms of Service apply to Context7. Upstash's total liability for Context7-related claims shall not exceed the fees paid for Context7 services in the preceding 12 months, or \$100 if Context7 is provided at no charge.

13. General Provisions

- This Addendum is governed by the same laws and dispute resolution procedures as the main Upstash Terms of Service
- If any provision of this Addendum is deemed invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions continue in full effect
- This Addendum does not supersede other Upstash terms unrelated to Context7
- Modifications to this Addendum require written agreement unless updated through Upstash's standard terms update process
